NW Documentary and OMSI connect scientific research and documentary filmmaking! Students work with peers to follow the entire filmmaking process – planning, researching, story development, filming, sound and editing. Combines science exploration, research, day hiking and kayaking amid awesome redwood trees with a trip to the best tide pools on the Pacific Coast. Films will be presented on the last day in OMSI's Academic Forum.

Camp is at Wolf Creek Education Center in Redwood National Park, located 50 miles south of the Oregon border and three miles from the Pacific Ocean. An old growth redwood grove, active trout and salmon spawning stream and direct access to Prairie Creek Redwood State Park makes this an exciting site for forest and coastal ecosystem explorations and filmmaking.
